

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Who are we?

The Study Hall College is an initiative of **Study Hall Educational Foundation** which is making its contribution in the field of education since last 30 years and has directly/indirectly educated/trained millions of students & thousands of teachers across the world with its schools and outreach programmes.

The Study Hall College is a college with a creative and entrepreneurial climate, where academics prepare students not only for helping them to carve out their future careers, but also for equipping them with skills and analytical abilities to effectively meet their social responsibilities in the Nation's democratic set-up. Here emphasis is on critical thinking with a social and political perspective, experiential learning and developing in them a '**problem solving and a solution oriented**' approach. The syllabus is an integrated curriculum focused on thematic units and is designed to meet each individual's personal goals. Industry oriented courses have been chosen for the students keeping creativity and eventual placement in mind.

The Study Hall College emphasis on emotional intelligence, critical thinking with a social and political perspective, experiential learning and developing a problem solving and a solution oriented approach.

The college is an inclusive place, with students from diverse caste and class backgrounds. Study Hall Educational Foundation at a Glance

Study Hall school started in 1986, over 30 years ago in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. It is now housed under the parent organization Study Hall Educational Foundation (SHEF), which is a Society, and runs multiple educational initiatives in urban and rural India. SHEF was established in 1994. Since its inception SHEF has reached out to over 2,50,000 students and lives through direct and indirect initiatives within Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan. Currently SHEF educates over 6000 students and trains over 8000 teachers directly, and works with over 1,50,000 students, teachers, young women indirectly through partnerships with social ventures, NGOs and the Govt. in Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan.

Study Hall Educational Foundation has been pursuing its mission to provide quality education to underprivileged girls and youth in urban and rural India. Using feminist-based pedagogy, gender sensitization techniques and adolescent empowerment discussions on social issues in the classrooms, SHEF works in the areas of education with a focus on girls' education and empowerment (1000 girls), teacher training programs - gender based sensitization workshops and trainings (746 schools – 1500 teachers), DIET trainings (7000 teachers across 70 DIETS) formal and non-formal educational centers (3500 students) and vocational trainings (100 women). SHEF has developed over 2000 content videos covering the state curriculum, special education, digital stories and teacher-training workshops. SHEF keeps the Girl Child and her development at the center of all initiatives, empowers girls through theatre and drama based education to become equal autonomous persons having the right to equal participation in society.

Study Hall Educational Foundation is striving to successfully fulfil the Millennium Development Goals, in India:

1. Eradicating extreme poverty and hunger
2. Achieving universal primary education
3. Promoting gender equality and empowering women

Study Hall Educational Foundation through its work, vision and dedication has committed to adopt 13 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) identified by the UNITED NATIONS at the UN Summit in September, 2015 in New York City, USA.

Study Hall School

An English medium co-educational secondary school, affiliated to C.B.S.E. and located in Gomti Nagar, Lucknow. Established in 1986, the school has a strength of over 1500 students who are being imparted education up to class XII standard in various streams.



Digital Study Hall

Digital Study Hall, started in 2005, is a research project that seeks to improve education for the poor children in slums and rural schools in India. It runs pilot "hubs" in India (Lucknow, Kolkata and Pune) and in Nepal.



Prerna Girls School

Prerna, is a K-12 school for underprivileged girls coming from economically poor backgrounds. These girls come from the neighbouring slums and communities and being compelled by their circumstances, most of them work in houses as domestic helpers.



Aarohini Initiative

Aarohini, has scaled Prerna's critical feminist pedagogy and girls empowerment program to over 100,000 teachers and students across UP and Rajasthan, through teacher training and community outreach campaigns.



GyanSetu

Gyansetu, an initiative of the Study Hall Educational Foundation (SHEF) that aims to take education to the children who do not reach schools. It acts as a bridge to fill the Gap.



Vidyasthali

Vidyasthali Kanar School, established in 2005, is a co - educational high school (UP Board and NIOS) situated in Kanar Village, 32 kilometres away from Lucknow, that enables 433 students from 55 villages to have access to quality education in their own area.



DOSTI

DOSTI, Study Hall's Inclusive School for specially-abled people, established in 2005 takes care of over 100 children through its Early Intervention, Home-based and Regular School Programmes. Children are identified in the initial stages of schooling and are included in the programs designed to help (those who can) catch up with their developmental milestones.



Prerna Boys School

Prerna Boys School is a school for underprivileged boys from very poor economic backgrounds. It is an afternoon school that runs in the Study Hall Prep School and Study Hall Centre for Learning premises in Gomtinagar, Lucknow. Presently it has 165 students and 12 teachers.



Center For Learning

With an aim to help children cope with academic pressures of centralized board, CFL paces the curriculum for students with help of open school program. Centre for Learning was founded on 1st July, 2013 in an integrated set-up along with other SHEF units.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Study Hall College is established on an eco-friendly 1,50,000 + sq ft campus. The college campus runs on 100% solar energy and has building based on the concept of day light saving and rain water harvesting. The college campus also holds a portion where organic farming is being done. The college has state of the art infrastructural facilities with off-line & on-line library facility, advanced technological facilities, big airy classrooms of size 1100 sq ft, a beautiful cafeteria and a playground with a kho kho court, 2 volleyball court, badminton, and cricket (net practice) facility.





FACULTY

The Study Hall College has in its ranks, a vibrant and flexible team of teachers and administrative staff, highly qualified, skilled and experienced in the fields of Education, Media, Commerce, Computer Application, Drama, counselling and administration. Our faculty base also includes faculty from Spain, UK & US. Our faculty takes care of student learning needs not only during college years but beyond it. We believe to make our students life-long learners.

COURSES

All courses are of 3 years duration and comprise of 6 semesters.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Students of any stream (Arts/Commerce/Science) are eligible for BBA/BCA/B.COM/BA-JMC
- Minimum percentage –
 - For BBA & BCA
 - General/OBC students must have at least 50% marks in class 12th.
 - SC/ST students must have at least 45% marks in class 12th.
 - For B.COM/BA-JMC:
 - General/OBC students must have at least 40% marks in class 12th.
 - SC/ST students must have at least 33% marks in class 12th.

We also conduct a free 2 year English ACCESS microscholarship program on English proficiency supported by American (U.S.) Embassy.

ADMISSION

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR PROVISIONAL ADMISSION:

- ✓ 2 passport size photograph.
- ✓ 2 Photocopy of mark sheet & pass certificate of class 12th.
- ✓ 2 Photocopy of mark sheet & pass certificate of class 10th.
- ✓ Original School Leaving Certificate/Migration Certificate/Transfer Certificate
- ✓ Original Character Certificate issued by the school.
- ✓ 2 Photocopy of Aadhar Card.

Note: Admission confirmation is at the sole discretion of the college.

SUCCESS STORIES OF STUDENTS

Our Student from BA-JMC course, Shubhankar Bhanu Yadav and Anshi Yadav scored highest marks at University level in their 1st semester & 3rd semester examination respectively.
